Shire's Re-sheeting Program Ahead of Schedule

Indigo Shire's annual re-sheeting program has finished ahead of schedule. Taking five weeks to complete, this year's program spread gravel over 30 roads across the Shire, at a cost of \$426,000.

Council's Major Projects and Programs Team inspect the 926km of gravel roads across the Shire annually and prioritise them according to their condition. Gravel used in the re-sheeting program is taken from Horseshoe Quarry near Beechworth, which is owned by Indigo Shire, as well as taking material from other suppliers.

Roads included in this year's re-sheeting program include:

Sandy Creek - McGrath Lane, O'Neill's Lane, O'Dells Lane, Sandy Creek Road, Egans Lane, Smiths Lane

Yackandandah - Adams Lane, Flume Gully Road, Condons Track, Ben Valley Lane, Thorson Lane, Allans Flat Road

Beechworth - Finch Street, Six Mile Road, Mauger Road, Sydney Rd Access Lane, Rose Battery Lane, Bridge Street shoulders

Kergunyah - Lumby Lane, Spring Vale Lane

Indigo Creek - Brewers Lane

Stanley - Salamon Lane, Johnson Lane, Old Stanley Road

Bruarong - Martins Lane

Wooragee - Edmundson Lane

Charleroi - Miller Lane

Osborne's Flat - School

Rutherglen - Moodemere Road, Kilborn Road, Nashes Road, Notts Road, Kellys Road

Chiltern - Barambogje Road

Barnawartha - Eames Road, Lades Road, Soldiers Road
