## 7 Hours and 7 Minutes short film festival

The inaugural screening of the 7 Hours and 7 Minutes short film festival was held at the Bruarong Hall on Sunday 27 November from 7.30pm – 9.30pm. Film makers between 8 – 18 years were challenged to make a short film of no more than 7 minutes in length in 7 hours at a two week film making workshop which ran in the July school holidays, in Beechworth and the Alpine shire. Award winners included Grace Griffith – Best Drama, Houston Bodenhamer – Best Drama, Leah Nankervis – Best Comedy, Sam Matthews – Best Mockumentary, Phoebe Grant – Best comedy, Anna Ross – Best Animation.

This project is funded by the Bushfire Youth Recovery Gift, a partnership between Indigo and Alpine Shire Councils as part of the Victorian Bushfire Appeal to provide support services and community capacity building opportunities to young people of Bushfire affected communities. The project began in December 2009 and will conclude in December 2011.
