#### Items that WILL be accepted

carpet, mattresses, scrap metal, sump oil (Rutherglen and Beechworth only), whitegoods, household and garden furniture, car bodies (Rutherglen and Beechworth only).

#### Items that will NOT be accepted

domestic waste/recyclables, car bodies (at Yackandandah, Chiltern and Kiewa), industrial waste, building waste/rubble, batteries – all cleaning solvents/household chemicals, herbicides/pesticides, paint, unidentified chemicals green waste – garden waste, asbestos, tyres, televisions.

**White goods, scrap metal, car bodies and sump oil can be disposed of FREE OF CHARGE at any time during the year at the Rutherglen and Beechworth Transfer Stations during normal opening hours.**
