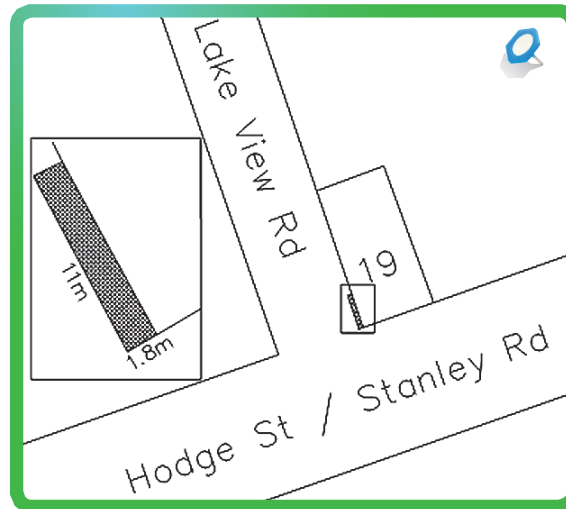

Notice is hereby given that the Indigo Shire Council, at its Ordinary Meeting on Tuesday 12 July 2011, resolved to give public notice of the proposed Partial Road Closure (19.8m<sup>2</sup>) of Lake View Road Beechworth. A copy of the Partial Road Closure of Lake View Road Beechworth can be inspected during office hours at any of Council's Customer Service Centres at Beechworth, Yackandandah, Rutherglen and Chiltern or viewed on Council's website at [www.indigoshire.vic.gov.au](http://www.indigoshire.vic.gov.au).
