(Section 52(1) Planning and Environment Act 1987)

This should be sent to the Manager Planning & Sustainable Development, PO Box 75 Yackandandah 3749.

The Responsible Authority will not decide on the application prior to 27 APRIL 2011. If you object, the Council will tell you its decision. Please be aware that copies of objections/submissions received may be made available to any person for the purpose of consideration as part of the planning process.
