Indigo Shire in the year 2030 – Come and tell us what you see?

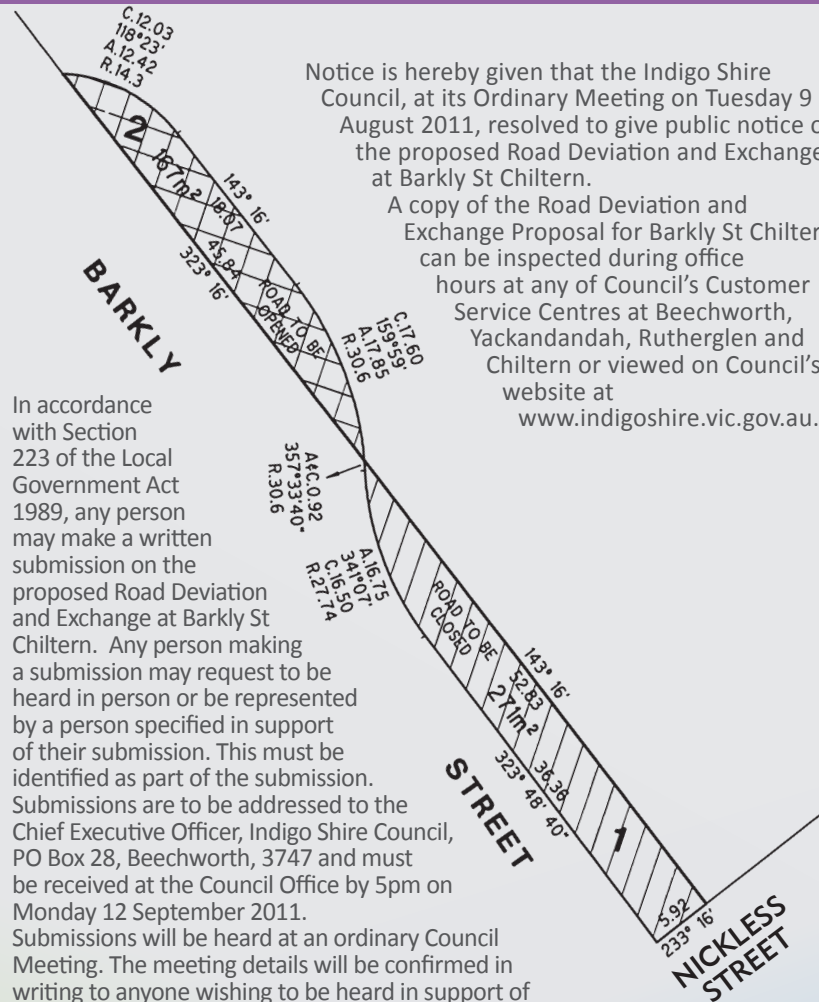

Barkly St Chiltern – Road Deviation and Exchange



Notice is hereby given that the Indigo Shire Council, at its Ordinary Meeting on Tuesday 9 August 2011, resolved to give public notice of the proposed Road Deviation and Exchange at Barkly St Chiltern.

A copy of the Road Deviation and Exchange Proposal for Barkly St Chiltern can be inspected during office hours at any of Council's Customer Service Centres at Beechworth, Yackandandah, Rutherglen and Chiltern or viewed on Council's website at www.indigoshire.vic.gov.au.

In accordance with Section 223 of the Local Government Act 1989, any person may make a written submission on the proposed Road Deviation and Exchange at Barkly St Chiltern. Any person making a submission may request to be heard in person or be represented by a person specified in support of their submission. This must be identified as part of the submission. Submissions are to be addressed to the Chief Executive Officer, Indigo Shire Council, PO Box 28, Beechworth, 3747 and must be received at the Council Office by 5pm on Monday 12 September 2011. Submissions will be heard at an ordinary Council Meeting. The meeting details will be confirmed in writing to anyone wishing to be heard in support of their submission. Please note that unless Council is advised to the contrary by the submitter, the submission may be made available to the public as part of a Council Agenda.
