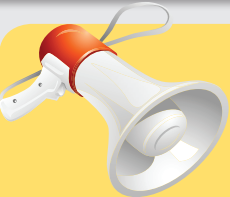

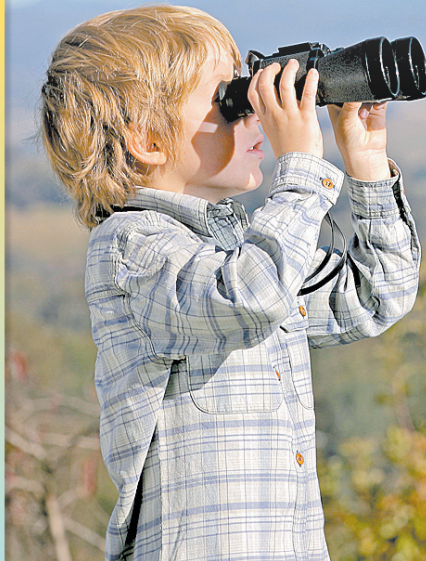
Construction of a Skate Bowl at Tangambalanga - Contract Number 11/2844

Notice of an application for planning permit

(Section 52(1) Planning and Environment Act 1987)

An application for planning permit has been made which may affect you.

The Responsible Authority will not decide on the application prior to: Wednesday 24 August 2011.

If you object, the Council will tell you its decision.
