Bring your hard waste to the sites listed below on 18 and 19 June for free disposal (no kerbside pickup)

- 18 & 19 June 1pm -5pm Beechworth**  
Beechworth Transfer Station - Diffey Road Beechworth
- 18 & 19 June 9am -1pm Yackandandah**  
Indigo Shire Depot - Railway Avenue Yackandandah (behind YCDCo Service Station)
- 18 & 19 June 8am-12noon Chiltern**  
Former Chiltern Transfer Station - Chiltern Rutherglen Road Chiltern
- 18 & 19 June 1pm -5pm Rutherglen**  
Rutherglen Transfer Station - Cornishtown Road Rutherglen
- 18 & 19 June 9am -1pm Kiewa/Tangambalanga**  
Kiewa Oval reserve - Kiewa East Road Kiewa

 **Items that WILL be accepted:** Carpet, mattresses, scrap metal, sump oil (Rutherglen and Beechworth only), whitegoods, household and garden furniture, car bodies (at Beechworth and Rutherglen only).

 **Items that will NOT be accepted:** Domestic waste/recyclables, car bodies (at Yackandandah, Chiltern and Kiewa), industrial waste, building waste/rubble, batteries -all, cleaning solvents/household chemicals, herbicides/pesticides, paint, unidentified chemicals, green waste - garden waste, asbestos, tyres and televisions.

White goods, scrap metal, car bodies and sump oil can be disposed of FREE at any time during the year at the Rutherglen and Beechworth Transfer Stations during normal opening hours. Council is currently in the process of awarding a tender to allow for the disposal of televisions and other E-Waste products. Residents will be advised when these products can be disposed of at the Rutherglen and Beechworth Transfer Stations. There will be a disposal charge for these items.
