## Special Council Meeting Budget adoption

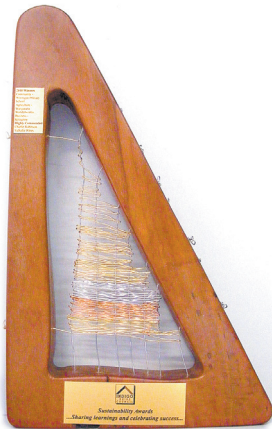

## Community and Business Directories

These directories have been updated in recent weeks. In the coming weeks, a search page will be developed, where people can search for groups by keyword, town or category. The two directories were originally in one Community Directory on Council's website, but have been separated because they serve different needs. The updating process involved contacting more than 1300 groups and organisations already listed to confirm their contact details. Several emails and letters were sent and, in some cases, followed up with phone

calls and personal visits. Because these directories are a community resource, it is important that information on them be confirmed as accurate and up to date. There were a handful of entries in both directories that could not be confirmed and these have been deleted. ## Notice of an application for Planning Permit

(Section 52(1) Planning and Environment Act 1987)

An application for a planning permit has been made which may affect you.

- The Land affected by the application is located at: 5 Warner Road, Beechworth (formerly Ovens & Murray Hospital for the Aged)

Any person who may be affected by the granting of the permit may object or make other submissions to the Responsible Authority.

An objection must be sent to the Responsible Authority in writing. Include the reasons for the objection and state how the objector would be affected.

The responsible authority will not decide on the application before 6 July, 2011. If you object the Responsible Authority will advise you of its decision.

Objections or submissions must be sent to The Manager, Planning and Development Services, Indigo Shire Council, PO Box 75, Yackandandah 3749.

Please be aware that copies of objections/submissions received may be made available to any person for the purpose of consideration as part of the planning process.
