Wodonga council holds free immunisation clinics which are open to all members of the community. **Due to the COVID-19 social distancing requirements, all immunisation services will be by appointment only. Contact 1800 655 360 to book.** If the client to be vaccinated is under 18 years, consent for vaccination must be given by a parent or legal guardian. Clients being vaccinated must wait at the venue for 15 minutes after vaccines have been administered.

## What to bring:

- Your Medicare card; and
- Your vaccination record/your child's health record.

## Vaccines available:

- Free of charge vaccines: All vaccines on the National Immunisation Program Schedule; and
- Fee for service vaccines (*PLEASE NOTE: These vaccines are available free of charge to certain groups*): Influenza, Whooping Cough, \*Hepatitis A and B vaccines (\*cannot be provided for travel purposes) – please phone 2 weeks prior to attending an immunisation session, to ensure the vaccine is available for you. Cash and EFTPOS payment is accepted at all immunisation sessions.
